1	COMPLETE COURSES: Complete required pathway courses with B or better .	Pathway Course Sequences begin on page 22 of the HSD 2020-2021 Course Catalog	
2	CAPSTONE PROJECT: Complete a culminating capstone project as assigned by your capstone teacher.	As the senior project is not required for graduation this year, students are, instead, required to complete a capstone project as assigned by the teacher of the capstone course. It is teacher discretion for project requirements. This project <i>could</i> look very similar to the senior project requirements, or it may be entirely different. If required, It should provide students an opportunity to showcase the skills they have mastered through the CCP.	
3	VIRTUAL CAREER EXPERIENCE (VCE) <i>The VCE is in lieu of the typically required ELO. As we are unable to send students to in-person ELO experiences this year, we have created a simple menu of alternative options for students. The flexibility in choice will provide students the ability to select an option that best fits their schedule and interests.</i>	Choose 1 of 6 options below to meet the VCE Requirement:

Within two weeks of the event date, or when an event has filled to capacity, the link to register for that event will be removed and confirmation emails, with the Zoom passcode for the meeting, will be sent to registered students.	2hrs per session
Career Spotlight (Chamber of Commerce)	One-time event, synchronous or asynchronous (Ex: Career Days, Virtual Career Conversations, CRLE)	2hrs each
Virtual Job Fair (City of Hillsboro)	Information to come	1 day event
CCC Events	(Financial Aid Night, FAFSA/ORSAA Workshop, Scholarship Workshop, College or Career Information Session/Workshop) College/Career Presentations coordinated through HSD. (check your CCC calendar for event options)	1hr each
