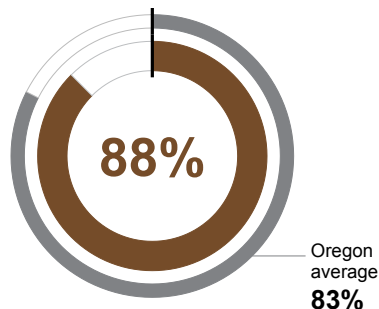
### Special Note

Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

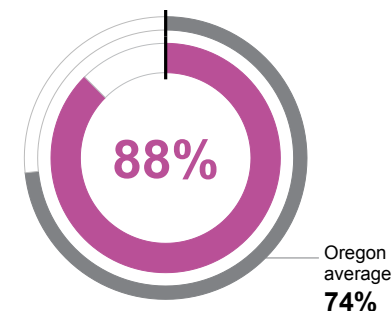

### Academic Progress

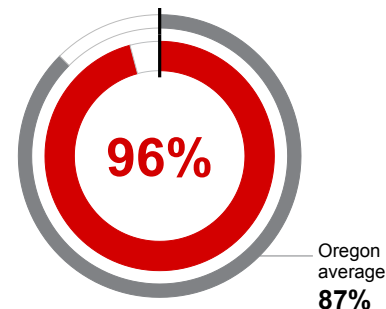
#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



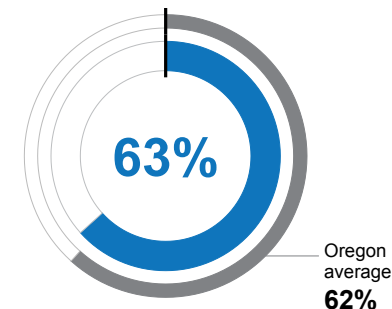
#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

### School Goals

School Goals: 1. Cultivate an inclusive and welcoming school culture through advisory classes that integrate the use of community building and restorative practices; 2. By the end of the 2021-22 school year, 100% of teachers will implement equitable grading practices with equal interval grading scales in every class; and 3. Increase purposeful student academic discourse across all classes.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

### Safe & Welcoming Environment

The best foundation for a safe, welcoming environment and student success is positive relationships between students and staff, and that is a priority at Century. Supports for students include Care Team, graduation coaches, a wellness counselor, Wellness Center, trauma informed practices, student clubs, activities, sports, and academic supports. Safety improvements at our building from bond funds include enhanced main entry security, interior door locks, security cameras, and card key access.

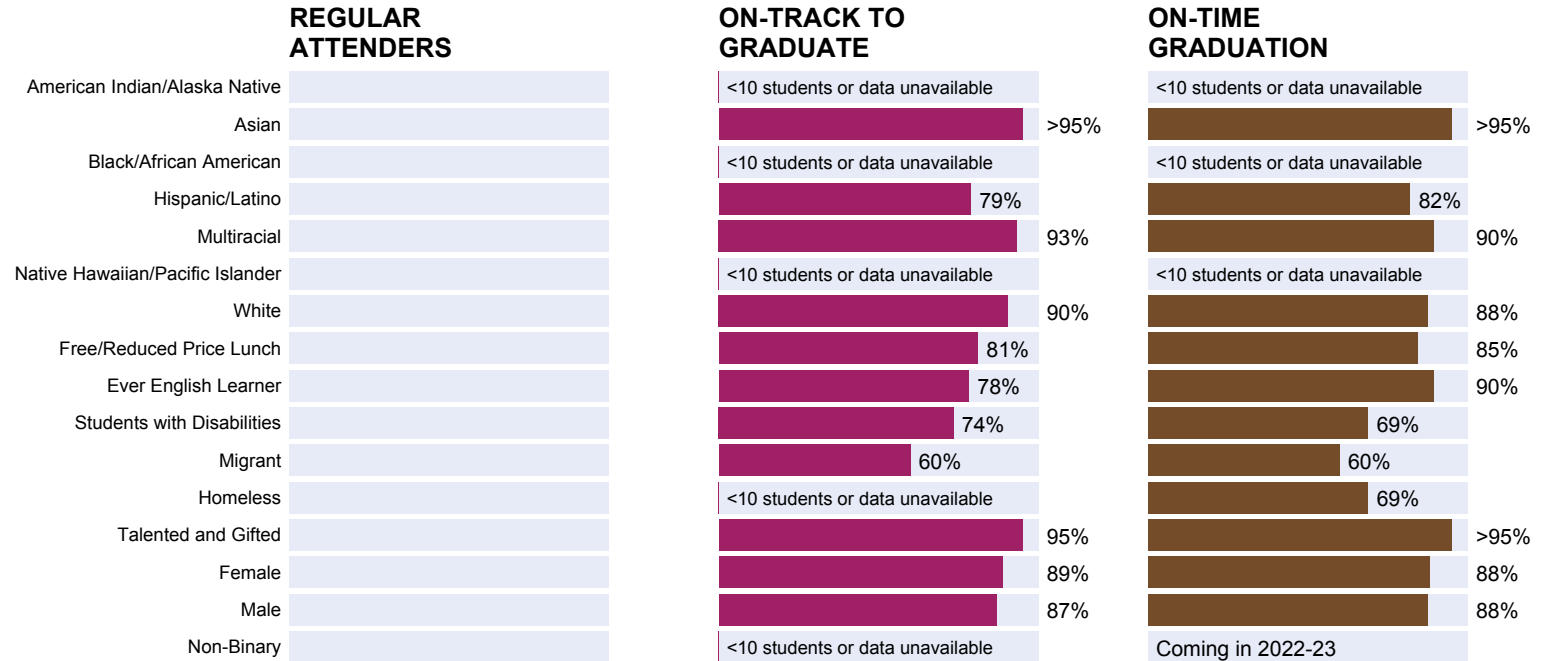

### About Our School

#### ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses: Studio Art, Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Environmental Science, European History, Government, Human Geography, Language and Composition, Literature and Composition, Music Theory, Physics, Psychology, Spanish Language, Spanish Literature, Statistics, U.S. History, 3-D Art Studio. Century also offers dual credit in 18 courses, including English, Health Sciences, Anatomy and Physiology, Communication, Child Development, Culinary Arts, Pre-Calculus, and Spanish with 80% of Century seniors taking one or more dual credit courses.

#### CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Century is proud to offer CTE programs in Business Education and Marketing, Drafting, Informational Technology, Engineering, Introduction to Digital Technology, Programming, Web Design, Research and Development, Child Development, Culinary Arts, Health Services, and Graphic Design. Additionally, Century students have access to Automotive Technology, Welding, Aerospace and Fire Science at other HSD campuses using a daily inter-campus shuttle. After school CTE programs include DECA, Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) and the Software Entrepreneurs Club.

#### EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Century is proud to offer 21 OSAA sports and six interscholastic clubs; 30 academic clubs; 5 service clubs; Drama and thespians; Marching band, color guard and drumline; Variety of choirs; and Leadership program.

#### PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Parent involvement and support is crucial to the success of our students. We work to reach and involve our school community through surveys, parent nights (AVID, Back to School, award nights, Parent Conferences, Incoming Freshmen Night, FAFSA Night, PCA events), outreach to middle school families, newsletters, and principal emails.
