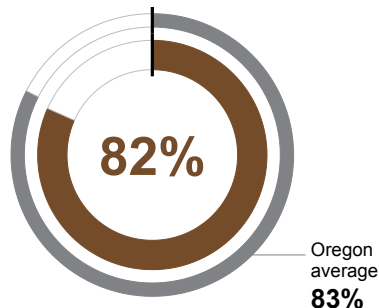
### Special Note

Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

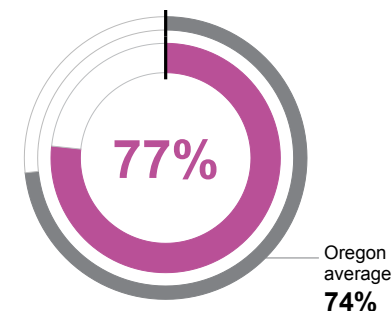

### Academic Progress

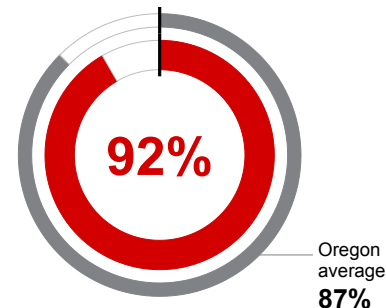
#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



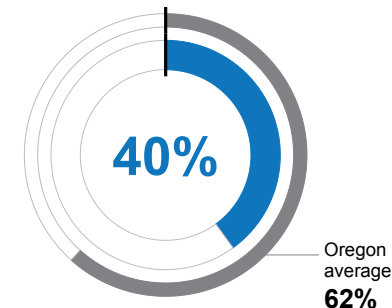
#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

### School Goals

The goal of Hillsboro Online Academy (HOA), an option school for Hillsboro School District students in grades K-12, is to provide an inclusive, supportive, and flexible learning environment for students and families who seek a rigorous, standards-based, quality alternative to the traditional school framework.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

### About Our School

#### ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Hillsboro Online Academy offers Honors and Accelerated options in all core courses.

#### CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Hillsboro Online Academy provides over 60 introductory Career and Technical Education Courses both to students attending HOA and to middle and high school students attending other schools in the District. Our students are also enrolled in specialized CTE programs throughout the District, such as Fire Science. Hillsboro Online offers a full Criminal Justice Career and College Pathway Program to high school students across the District.

#### EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Our school has a number of clubs, including: Robotics, Engineering, Art, and Running. This year, we will add a new Criminal Justice Club for students interested in careers in that field. Students at our school participate in OSAA athletics and activities at their neighborhood schools; Hillsboro Online is an OSAA Associate Member. Core courses at our school are NCAA-approved.

#### PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Hillsboro Online Academy engages stakeholders through a variety of events attended by students, their parents, and members of the community. These include Back-to-School Night, orientations for full-time and concurrently enrolled students, parent "How to Support Your Online Learner" sessions, Career and College Information nights, Science Fair, HOA Information Evenings, and Family Game Nights. Our school's parent's club, "Parent Connect," assists parents with their students' journey through online learning. Students access internship opportunities at local businesses through the Chamber of Commerce's "School-to-Career" program.
