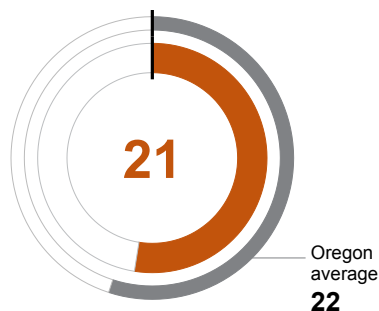

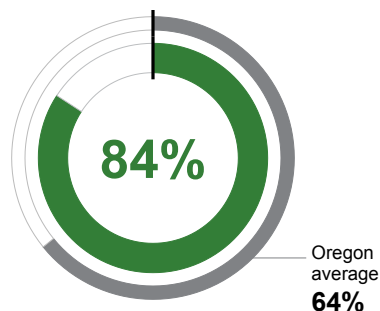

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

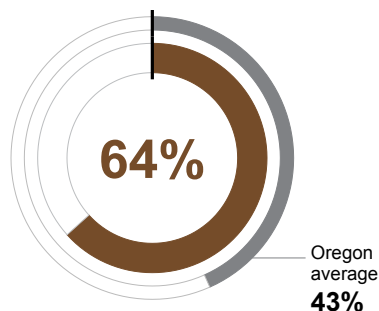
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

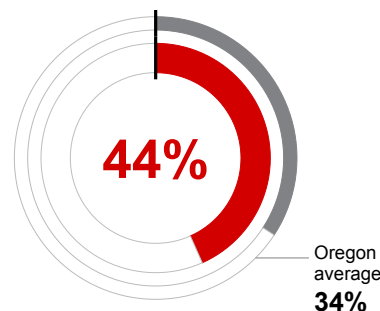
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



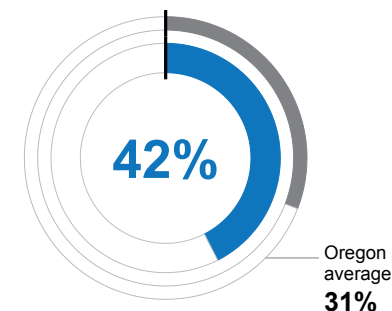
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Our goal is for each student to experience academic, social, and emotional growth, while feeling a sense of belonging. Our staff provides high-quality core instruction with differentiation and supports for students at their grade and instructional level. We are committed to a model of inclusion and equity where all students, staff, and community feel valued, are authentically engaged, and experience success. 2022-23 focus areas are Writing Instruction, Math Differentiation, English Language Development, and Social Emotional Learning.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Knowing students by name, strength, and need is the foundation of our school environment. Staff focus on building authentic connections and relationships with students throughout the day, starting by greeting each student by name five or more times before entering the classroom. Every classroom holds a Morning Meeting to build and foster a positive classroom culture. We continuously work on our strong Tier 1 structure of positive behavior support and recognition. Staff work on building consistency, predictability, and routine across all environments.

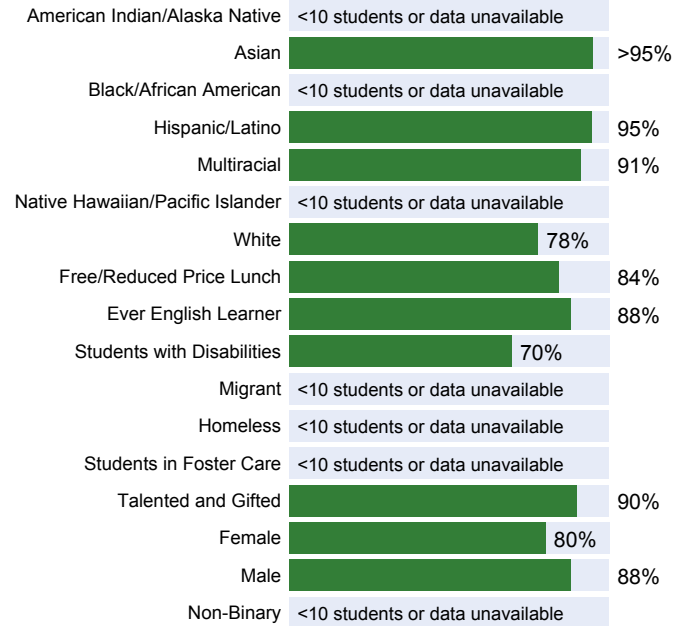

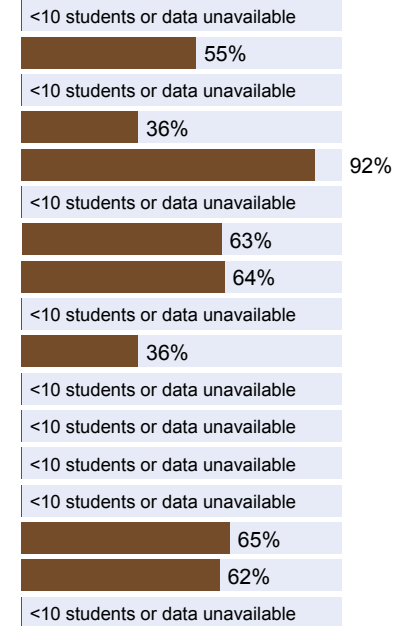

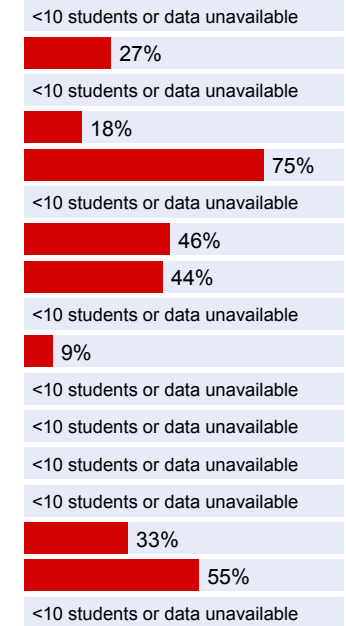

As a new school that had to navigate COVID protocols, we are looking to build our extracurricular activities in the future. We have started off with 6th grade Band, 5th/6th Drama Club, and Next Level Affinity Group. In the upcoming year, we are looking to add Battle of the Books, STEAM Club, Girls on the Run, 6th grade Leadership, and Change Makers.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Atfalati Ridge has an active Booster Club (Blue Jay Boosters) who provide and support a variety of activities and events for our students. These include events such as Run-4-Fun, Blue Jay Bazaar, Blue Jay Family Night, McTeacher's Night, Trunk or Treat, and Field Day. Parents are invited into the building multiple times a year for academic-related events hosted by our staff with a student focus. Parents receive communication through the principal's weekly newsletter, and a weekly or monthly classroom newsletter from their teacher. In 2022-23, Principal Chats will be offered on a monthly basis.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The North Plains community is very supportive of our school. Our Chamber of Commerce and community partners join our Family Night events, visit our classrooms, and support our students through volunteering and donations. The North Plains Public Library is one of our biggest supporters and partners. In addition, Mayor Teri Lenahan is a visible presence in our school, especially in promoting and honoring youth who aspire to learn more about her role in the community. On campus, we value the opportunity for our families to enroll their child or children in after school care with Vermont Hills. In 2022-23 we are proud to partner with NWRESA to offer a preschool program on campus.
