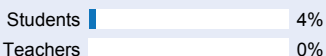

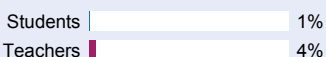

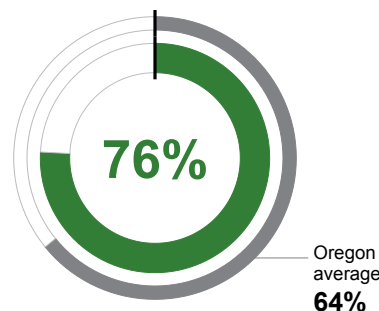

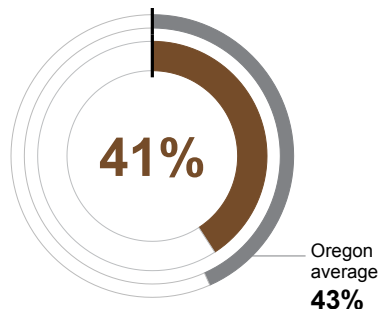

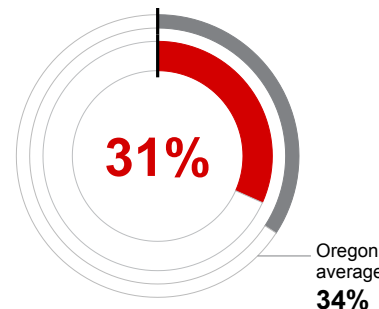

Academic Progress

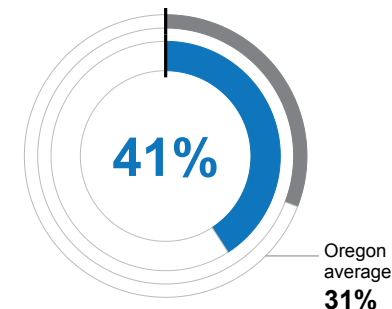
INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

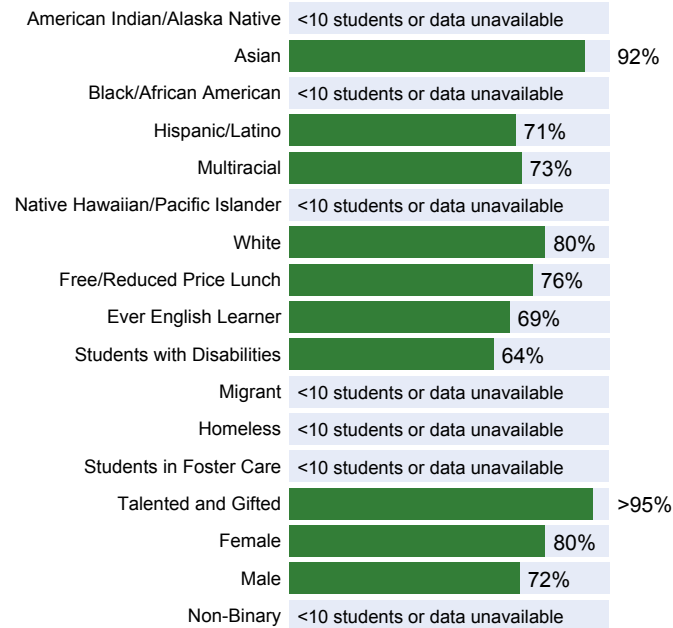

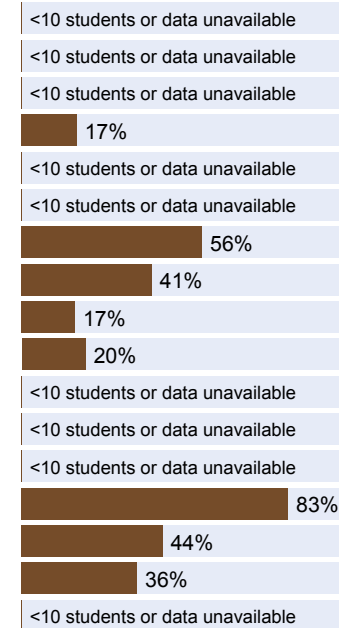

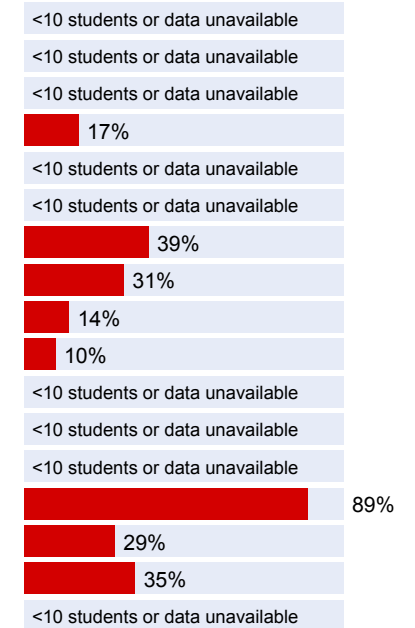
