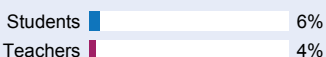

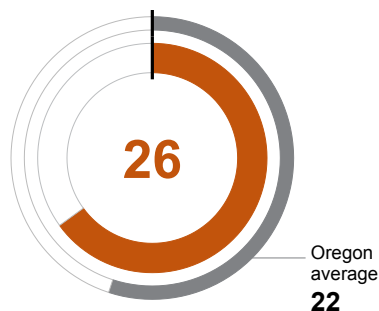

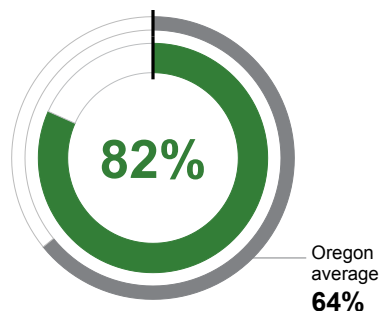
#### CLASS SIZE

#### INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

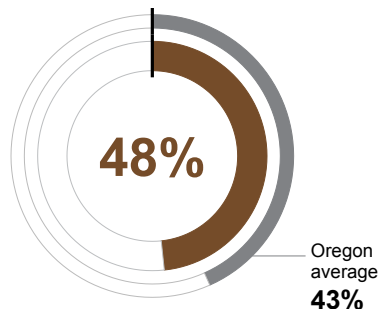

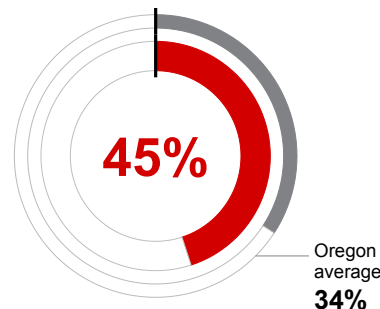
#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



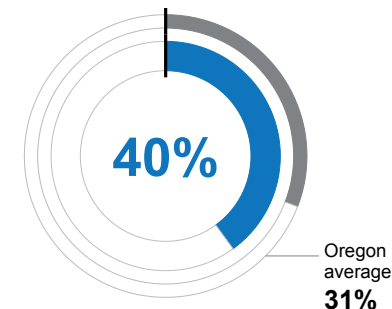
#### MATHEMATICS

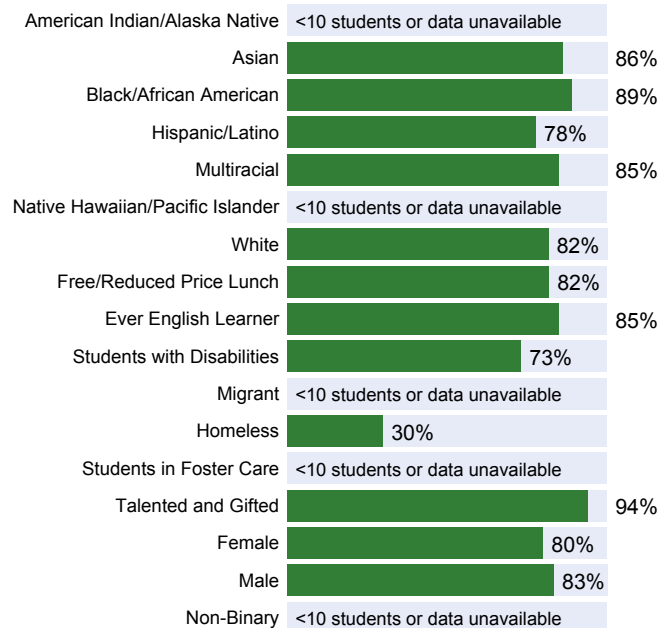

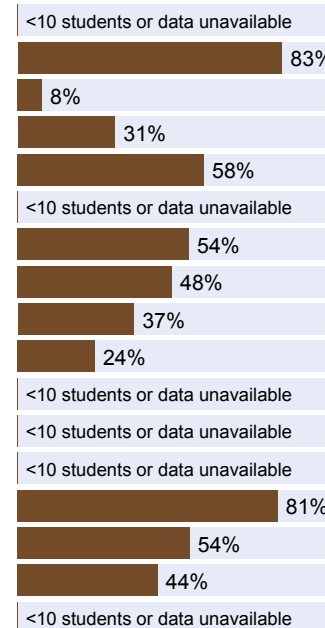

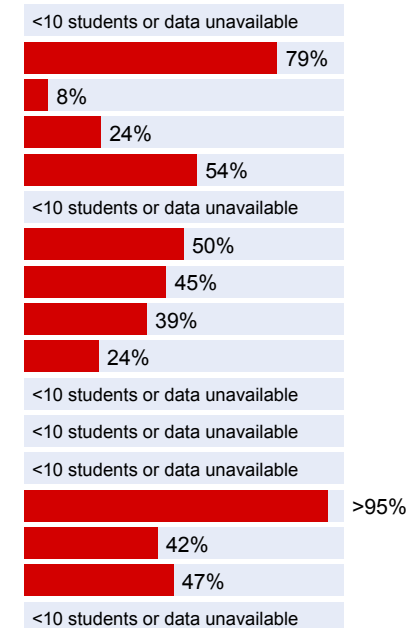
