Dedication of New Pathways Center on the Oak Street Campus

Hillsboro School District officially dedicates its new Pathways Center, which houses career and college pathway programs and resources, accessible to all students districtwide.

January 28, 2022, Hillsboro, OR - An outdoor ceremony will be held to officially dedicate and open the new Pathways Center building on the Oak Street Campus (formerly Miller Education Center-West) at 8:30 a.m. on Wednesday, February 2. Small group tours inside the building will follow at about five-minute intervals.

This \$4.3 million, 8,400 sq. ft. building in downtown Hillsboro will centralize career and college pathway programs; post-secondary planning, advising and coaching resources; and other academic services. Five classrooms, an extended learning area, and several offices are housed there. Pathways Center services will be available to all students districtwide, and are conveniently accessible via nearby light rail and bus transportation.

The Pathways Center received \$2.9 million in capital project funding from the 2017 Hillsboro School District Bond as well as \$1.4 million from the State of Oregon's Measure 98 funding to facilitate on-track graduation and readiness for career and college.

The media is invited to this community celebration. Note that attendance is limited to 50 people due to COVID-19 protocols in the limited space available. Masks will be required on campus.
