Transfer Window Open in Hillsboro School District

Resident and non-resident student transfer requests will be accepted through May 29

May 1, 2015, Hillsboro, OR – Hillsboro School District is now accepting both in-district (resident) and inter-district (non-resident) student transfer requests, and will do so through Friday, May 29.

At their meeting on Tuesday, April 28, the Hillsboro School Board voted to allow up to 40 non-resident students to request a transfer to Hillsboro School District schools for 2015-16, and to allow up to 40 resident students to request a release so that they may attend school in a different district.

Non-resident students are reminded that they must also obtain a release from their home district to be considered for a transfer request to Hillsboro School District.

All forms and information, including the [inter-district transfer form](#), an inter-district transfer [process document](#), and a [list](#) of the number and location of potential openings for inter-district transfers, are posted on the District's website under Parents/[Transfer Requests](#).

All transfer requests will be reviewed in mid-June, and decisions will be mailed by June 30.

The in-district transfer process for kindergarten students will take place August 1-21.

Please note that Groner Elementary School will be transitioning to [Groner K-8](#) in the 2015-16 school year. Transfer requests to Groner are currently being accepted for grades K-7.
