Open Enrollment Inter-District Transfer Slots Announced

Process governed by HB3681 does not require home district release

March 1, 2015, Hillsboro, OR – Hillsboro School District has opened 40 spots for students residing in other districts who wish to attend Hillsboro schools. A list of the potential available spots at each school is available on our website under [Students/Transfer Requests](#).

Students are asked to keep in mind the following important points:

- Students entering grades 10-12 who transfer through the open enrollment process will lose one year of eligibility for OSAA-sanctioned athletics and activities.
- Transportation will not be provided.* (*To access Hillsboro School District transportation, a student would have to get themselves to a designated bus stop on the existing route to their requested school and there would have to be space available on the bus as determined by Transportation staff.)

[Applications](#) will be accepted through Tuesday, March 31; student placement will be determined by the end of April.

There will be a separate process for in-district (Hillsboro School District resident) transfer requests beginning April 1, 2015, and there will be another opportunity afforded to students residing in other districts who wish to transfer to Hillsboro; however, that process will be guided by HB2747 rules and will not begin until May 1, 2015. Additional information about the HB2747 process will be announced in late April.
