Instructional Coaching in the School District of Onalaska:

- Supports the use of best practices in all schools through instructional coaching.
- Partners with instructional staff to continuously improve instructional planning, culturally responsive teaching practice, and the use of data, assessment, and instructional technology.
- Provides feedback through collaboration to enhance and support the development of all instructional staff and leadership.
- Assists teachers in the development of their year-long curriculum.
- Analyzes data with collaborative teams in order to respond to student needs.
- Communicates best instructional practices with the community.
- Provides ongoing professional development for instructional staff:
 - Individual or team: job-embedded professional development through student-centered coaching cycles, responding to student evidence using best practices, co-teaching, and co-planning.
 - District-wide: training and workshops to support the common understanding of best instructional practices and their impact on student learning.
- Supports the implementation of a comprehensive curriculum and pacing guide using the Wisconsin State Standards.
- Researches, implements and assesses research-based instructional practices and the effects on student achievement.
