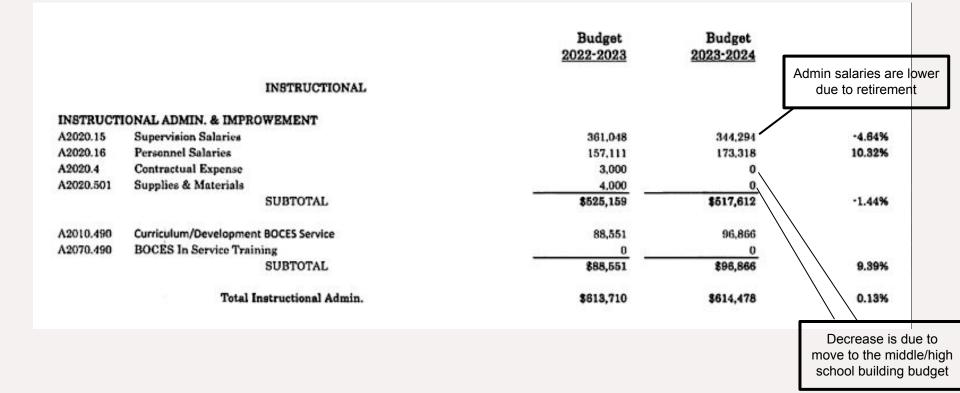

### PROPOSITIONS

#### Transportation

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Caledonia-Mumford Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake the acquisition of one (1) 65-passenger school bus, at an estimated maximum cost upto \$200,000, less trade-in value, if any, and such costs, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$200,000 shall be issued, or the school district may enter into an installment purchase contract if the Board of Education determines that it is in the best interest of the school district to finance the purchase in that method.

### PROPOSITIONS

#### Vehicle/Equipment Reserve Proposition

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Caledonia-Mumford Central School District be authorized and directed to establish a reserve fund pursuant to Education Law Section 3651 to be known as the "2023 Vehicle and Equipment Reserve Fund" for the purpose of financing, in whole or in part, the purchase of vehicles, equipment, machinery or apparatus, furnishings, and costs incidental thereto, including transportation vehicles (buses and vans), buildings and grounds equipment, furnishings, and other equipment, machinery or apparatus incidental thereto or separately, provided that such capital costs are an object or purpose that would be eligible for financing under the Local Finance Law, with the ultimate amount of such reserve fund not exceeding One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), plus any accrued earnings on amounts deposited in such reserve fund, the probable existence of said reserve fund being ten (10) years, but with said reserve fund continuing in existence for its stated purpose until liquidated in accordance with Education Law, and the source from which funds shall be obtained for said reserve Fund, and (b) current and future unappropriated fund balances from the General Fund of the District, as directed by the Board of Education; (c) State aid related to expenditures from said reserve fund; (d) transfers from other reserve funds; (e) any other appropriations authorized by the voters from time to time; and (f) interest earnings.

#### **Capital Outlay Project**

- Law provides that a district may receive building aid in the following aid year for one project each year in the district not to exceed \$100,000.
- Require voter approval (in this case budget approval)
- Must be paid by budget appropriation and applied to one building code.
- District may not use borrowed money for these purposes.

#### What are we doing this year?

Replacing four (4) HVAC (PTAC) units in the Elementary School Main Office. If funds permit, we will replace one (1) additional HVAC (PTAC) unit in the Elementary Nurses Office.
