








See How Your School District Is Recovering From the Pandemic

Researchers at Stanford and Harvard conducted a study, the Education Recovery Scorecard, which shows how elementary and middle school students are recovering from pandemic learning losses.

FCASD students in grades 3-8 are more than 3 years ahead of Pennsylvania averages, according to both standardized mathematics and reading assessment scores.




Grades 3-8 Mathematics
