Elementary Program Highlights:

- Kindness Week
 - Kindness activities, spirit week, challenges
- National School Counseling Week

Individual Counseling:

Short term counseling
Parent referrals, teacher/staff referrals, self-referrals
Students can self-referral by getting in contact with one of us, having teachers/staff reach out, self-referral google form

Small Group Counseling:

6-8 small group sessions

Topics can include - social skills, self-regulation, self-esteem

Students are identified by counselors, classroom teachers or staff

Elementary School Counseling Lessons -


School counseling lessons taught daily to grades K-5

Each class receives counseling lessons twice a month

Topics include:

Diversity, empathy, identifying emotions, self-esteem, decision making, career exploration, friendship, self-regulation, growth

mindset, conflict resolution

- Career Day:
