- I. Welcome & Introductions
 - A. Members present:

 - B. Recap from last meeting
 1. Previous SHAC meetings were canceled due to not having the minimum number of members present as required.
- II. Updates
 - A. Health curriculum (feedback on program)
 1. Mrs. Mabry and her students offered feedback on the EXPLORE health program.
 - a) “It is going well!!! All permission slips turned in and all parents were ok with all the lessons. Students seem to be responsive to it, but of course I am learning things that I might do differently next year to make it even more engaging. I am interested in bumping up to the high school book.
 - b) I did ask the students today if they felt like they could go up a level, and they all said yes. I think we should use the high school workbook next year.”
 - B. Mental Health Awareness training
 1. Iola ISD employees completed the Mental Health Awareness Training on April 10. This is a 6 hour in-person training that is required every 3 years. The trainers were mental Health First Aid coordinators and instructors. Every year, employees will receive a refresher training.



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2. The MHFA coordinator reached out to secondary principal, Mr. Fowler, about offering mental health awareness trainings for 11th and 12th graders next year.
