President Coers, Superintendent Koehl, Wrestling Coach Rob Stoelzle and Coach LaDue recognized the State wrestlers. Dustan Davidson, Dylan Davidson, Cameron Wodocheck, Noah Geis, Caleb Carriel, Jarrid Braunagel, Alex Williams, Mason Hewitt and Nick Kelly competed at the state level.

Coach Stoelzle said that the wrestlers placed 7<sup>th</sup> in state with nine wrestlers. Dustan Davidson, a two time

state qualifier placed 6<sup>th</sup> at state. Mason Huet, a two time state qualifier placed fifth in state. Alex Williams is a three time state qualifier and placed fourth this year. The Wrestling State Champion is Jarrid Braunagel. The athletes were congratulated for their fantastic performance and each received a Certificate of Accomplishment.

## **FINANCIAL REPORTS**

The State of Illinois owes District 90 \$707, 786.43 in categorical. Dr. Koehl reported that the state aid is prorated to 95%. District 90 has received 76.53% or \$4,631,538.88 of the budgeted state aid.

Superintendent Koehl was please to report that District 90 has maintained it's A+ Standard and Poor's rating.
