The scholarship will be based on the student's academic achievements, service to others, financial need and information provided on this application, and is subject to approval by the Rotary Club of Boardman' Board of Directors.

Review and selection of scholarship applicants will occur by mid-April and a final decision will be provided to your high school by April 30th.

Boardman Rotary Scholarship Information

Please provide the following information to be considered for a scholarship:

Requirements:

1. Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school.
2. Applicant must be a senior.
3. Applicant must be able to provide proof of financial need.
4. Applicant must attach an official high school transcript.
5. Applicant must attach two letters of personal reference.
6. Applicant must attach a 125-word paper detailing their service to others OR submit a 2–3-minute video essay. Video submissions should be the URL of a YouTube video.
7. Applicants who are relatives of members of the Rotary Club of Boardman will be considered for a scholarship if the applicant meets all qualifications as outlined above. Family involvement in the Rotary Club of Boardman will not count against the applicant's eligibility.

Procedures:

1. The Rotary Club of Boardman is the sponsoring organization and the award is the responsibility of the Board of Directors of The Rotary Club of Boardman.
2. The selection will be made by a committee selected by The Rotary Club of Boardman.
3. The Scholarship payment will be payable directly to the college or university upon proof of enrollment.
4. The scholarship will be presented at the senior awards assembly.
5. All programs and activities of the Boardman Rotary are available to all on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, handicap, or religious affiliation.
6. The Rotary Club of Boardman is a non-profit organization.
