Belize 2024 Packing List

Casual clothes for everyday wear - clothes that are comfortable, lightweight & dry easily are best. The weather tends to be hot & humid. Modest clothing will be required at all times. We also suggest at least one change of clothes per day plus a couple extra changes just in case.

- Passport/Passport Card
- Pants or shorts for work days (shorts must be modest, loose fitting, athletic shorts)
- Shorts for excursion days and for around Jaguar Creek
- Lightweight short sleeve t-shirts (no tank tops)
- Lightweight long sleeve shirts & pants for the evening (insect protection)
- Lightweight waterproof jacket
- Small umbrella
- Modest swimsuit (two piece is okay if a dark shirt is worn over.)
- Beach towel for swimming (Jaguar Creek provides bath towels for use in your room, but ***does not*** provide beach towels.)
- Water shoes or Teva-like shoes (Rocks in the creek are sharp and flip flops won't do)
- Sturdy, lightweight shoes for working, hiking, walks
- Business casual outfit for church
- Sturdy work gloves (for service project)
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Bible, journal, pen & paper, etc.
- Toiletries
- Any necessary Medication
- Wash cloth
- Zip-lock bags (gallon size are great for packing wet clothing)
- Day Bag/Backpack (Flights and Work Site)
 - Water bottle (reusable) - Water refill will be available each day on worksites
 - Any necessary medication
 - Sunglasses & hat
 - Sunscreen
 - Insect repellent
 - Camera/Phone and charger (no wifi at Jaguar Creek)
 - Cash for "extras" (no more than \$200)
 - Breakfast/lunch in airport on 3/23
 - Dinner in airport on 3/30
