NOTES ON GRADUATION & COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS:

- Students must earn a grade of **D** or above in each semester of a course to receive credit towards graduation. A grade of **C** or above is required for A-G Eligibility.
- A grade of A in a regular class is a 4.0 GPA, a grade of A in an Honors or AP class is a 5.0 GPA.
- LHS recommends a **maximum** of two Honors or AP classes per year.
- In order to graduate from Lincoln High School, a student must have successfully completed a total of 230 credits.
