

- A key card system was added to the district office with a video doorbell.



## TIPS & TRICKS

- Quick list of tips for staying safe online. Staying safe online requires constant effort. Here is my list of items to start with when it comes to online safety:
- NEVER share personal information, especially cell phone numbers, with anyone. We've gotten to the point where we give our number to everyone, but that number can also be tied to various services for a recovery method or two-factor authentication code.
