Exercising Your Right to Vote: How to Register

To register to vote, you must fill out a Texas voter registration application, available online at www.votetexas.gov/register-to-vote/ or by mail or at the voter registration locations below. The application must be received in the county voter registrar's office or postmarked 30 days before an election in order for you to be eligible to vote in that election. You may also register to vote when you apply for or renew your driver license.
