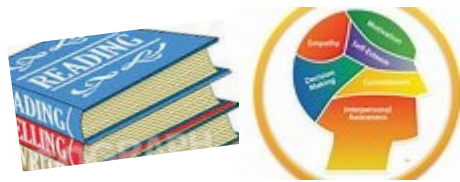

CLAYTON COUNTY DISTRICT GOALS

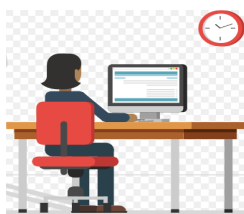
Clayton County Public Schools will increase the percentage of students scoring at the Proficient and/or Distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones by at least 8 percentage points in each content area.

Clayton County Public Schools will increase the graduation rate to 90% or higher.



Eddie White Middle Academy 6-8 grade Goals

Eddie White Middle Academy's focus for 23-24 school year will be increasing content mastery in every content area by 8 percentage points. Teachers will also focus on proof of learning assessments and teacher professional learning communities. The proof of learning assessments will help the students show progress toward mastery of the standard and show teachers what the students know. Teachers' participation in the professional learning communities will support teachers' growth in providing students with instructional support.



The Middle School Team

As a school, we will work with students and their families to increase students' success in all content areas by 8 percentage points to support academic growth.

School Will:

- Offer academic curriculum nights concentrating on literacy skills. Implement Close reading strategies in all content to help increase reading comprehension and vocabulary skills. Help students that have fallen further behind by providing remediation, tutorial sessions and after-school programs to help students catch up on their thinking skills.
- Use Canvas to inform and encourage students and parents regarding all content assignments. Use MAP and HMH Growth assessment data to monitor student growth in all content areas and Lexile level.
- Provide students with daily RE-THINK SEL ACTIVITIES and strategies. Have daily discussions on how to manage emotions, set positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationship.

Eddie White Middle Students will...

Eddie White Middle Academy student joined staff and parents to develop ideas how they can succeed in school and reach for the stars in Mathematics and Reading. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:

- Students will complete assignments online using Canvas and Tutor.com.
- Students will visit online reading/ math sites, practice weekly, and complete a log sheet.
- Students will share all correspondence related to school activities and events with their parents.
- Student will attend tutorials when available.

At Home

As EWMA family we will survey staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in literacy and mathematics.

- Allow for students to visit Reading and Writing websites at home or the library.
- Use reading and writing in home activities.
- Make Tutor.com available for student use.
- Hold virtual meeting with parents/students using Google Meet/Zoom on how parents can support learning at home. Teach students varied methods of how to use technology for academic success.
