## Notice Regarding the Right to Appeal:

The parties to this formal complaint have the right to appeal the determination of responsibility set forth above, or the District's dismissal of a complaint or any allegations therein, for the following reasons:

1. A procedural irregularity that affected the outcome;

2. New evidence that was not reasonably available at the time of the determination and could affect the outcome;

3. Conflict of interest on the part of a Title IX coordinator, investigator, or decision maker that affected the outcome.

A written appeal must be filed in writing with the Office of the Superintendent within ten (10) days of the issuance of this Determination of Responsibility.
