FARIBAULT TEACHING FELLOWS PROGRAM

This grant program is designed to increase the number of Black, Indigenous, or People of Color (BIPOC) who become teachers.

To qualify, you must meet one of the following requirements:

- Be a current Faribault Public Schools employee
- Have graduated from Faribault Public Schools - **or be on track to graduate this year!**
- Be a parent of a current Faribault Public Schools student or graduate
- Live within the Faribault Public School district boundaries

Three application deadlines per year:

- * March 1
- * May 1
- * October 1

YOU'LL RECEIVE:

- Up to \$5,000 per year in tuition assistance and/or stipends to assist with other living or college costs
- One-on-one **advising support** throughout the program
- Connection with a **mentor teacher**
