Adjourn into Committee Executive Session to Consider the Employment of a Public Employee

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Chairperson Pamela Bowers asked for a motion to recess into Executive Session to consider *Employment of Public Employee* to discuss the Superintendent's current and next year's evaluation.

Committee member Moroski made the motion and Committee member Messer seconded the motion. The Committee recessed into Executive Session at 2:01 p.m.

The Committee reconvened to public session at 2:25 p.m.

Administration Evaluation Review – Superintendent Mitchell

2019 – 2020 Evaluation Review

The Committee reported that the Superintendent's evaluation has been completed and that the Board is now reviewing the results of that assessment.

Committee member Moroski noted that some measures in the evaluation will not be met due to a change in State law that halted all testing.

Superintendent Mitchell reiterated that at the beginning of the school year, the Administration provided updates to the Board on the components of the Strategic Plan. She also reported that the Administration produced quarterly score cards for goals that are outlined in the Strategic Plan.

Per Mr. Moroski's comment, she also reported that some measures will not be measured this year in terms of the State Assessment.

Mr. Messer reported that he looks forward to the leadership determining ways to capture testing when a crisis occurs, as did the COVID-19.

2020 – 2021 Evaluation Discussion

The Committee discussed looking at the current evaluation measures in order to stream them down.

The group talked about and agreed about using the five goals outlined in the Strategic Plan as a guide to determine measures specific to Mrs. Mitchell and to “check the pulse periodically throughout the year.”

Other Business

Teachers Logging Interaction Data

Mr. Moroski informed the Committee about a concern that he received regarding the amount of data teachers are being asked to log regarding their interaction with students.

ASSIGNMENT: Superintendent Mitchell will look into the concern on May 4, 2020, during her PLT (Performance Leadership Team) meeting.

The concern has been added to the Board’s Community Concern log and the Administration has submitted a response on the Board’s Google Doc.

Mr. Messer inquired if conversations about the current new way of learning (virtual) should take place at the Board level or in the SAC meetings. He also asked if this needs to be an ongoing item on the SAC agenda.

The Committee talked about Mr. Messer’s request possibly being discussed in both the Health and Safety and Student Achievement committees.

The meeting adjourned at 2:47 p.m.
