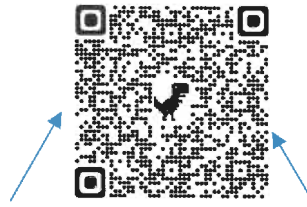

Due to the nature of the GOTR program, teams can only accept 16 girls.

Registration will be open Monday, August 21 at 10:00AM through Wednesday, August 30 at 11:59PM. If more than 16 girls apply, a random lottery\* will be conducted on September 1. If less than 16 girls apply, all girls' registrations will be processed on September 1.

Please follow the steps below to register into the online lottery. A maximum of 16 girls will be accepted into the program. Girls must be able to attend both lessons each week.

\*Registration is *not* conducted on a first come, first-served basis.

### **LOTTERY REGISTRATION PROCEDURE**

From Monday, 8/21 at 10:00 am through Wednesday, 8/30 at 11:59pm, please follow the steps to register:

2. Choose the appropriate program location (i.e. your school, community center, etc.)
3. Enter the appropriate information. You will need the following information to register online:
  - Girl's information, including t-shirt size and estimated shoe size
  - Parent/Guardian contact information
  - Health information
4. Please enter your payment information online using the following scale (payment plans are available for fees \$30 and up):

We accept credit or debit cards. You will only be charged if your participant is accepted on the team via the lottery on September 1. If you CANNOT pay your fee according to this scale, you can complete an online financial aid application (using the embedded link in the online registration form). The GOTR office will contact you before the start of the season to finalize your financial assistance terms.

Where will your child be after school this year? Consider the Dunham Recreation Center's After School Day Camp Program! We have caring, considerate staff and pick up at **Covedale, Dater Montessori** and **St. Teresa** in our city van. We offer 100 acres, two playgrounds, disc golf, three baseball fields, hiking trails, free leagues your child can participate in (soccer, dodgeball, floor hockey, basketball, etc.), homework help, arts and crafts, open ended creative time, special presenters, and special activities. We also host Girls on the Run at our site!

The Program is for children in grades K-6. The registration fee is \$112, which registers your camper and covers care for the month of August **starting on Monday, August 21st**. The fee for subsequent months, which is based on Cincinnati Public's school calendar, is **\$280 per month per child**. Participants must have a CRC membership to register. Memberships cost \$2/year for youth under 18 and can be purchased during registration. Ace Ohio is allocating money for After School programs once guardians have created accounts, paid for the service and submit receipts. There is about an 8-12 week timeframe before the money is reimbursed. Our only involvement in the process is confirming payment.
