We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Berkshire Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. However, our school has not been given one of these labels.

As an administrator at Berkshire Middle School, I'm proud to highlight our commitment to diversity and inclusivity, ensuring every student's unique learning needs are met irrespective of race, ethnicity, or socioeconomic status. Collaboratively, we work to eliminate learning and opportunity gaps among our students, enhancing our Multi-Tiered Support System (MTSS) Committee's ability to identify and assist those in need. Through initiatives like student support coaching and specialized intervention classes, such as L.E.A.D.E.R.S. or Strategies courses, we strive to foster academic and social growth for all students, embodying our dedication to a supportive and enriching educational environment.
