Criteria and requirements for this award is as follows:

- The applicant must provide verification of an official diagnosis of autism.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator at the high school.
- A statement from the applicant and family on the impact this award would have on the applicant's goals. If admission to a program has been granted, please include a copy of the acceptance letter. If application to a program is still in process, please provide status as a part of this statement.
