

2024 Scholarship Application Form



The Local Seen by PACTV is a nonprofit community media center that serves the towns of Duxbury, Kingston, Pembroke and Plymouth. The Local Seen provides media production training to people interested in creating their own content, coverage of government meetings, educational access at Pembroke High School, Silver Lake Regional Middle School and Silver Lake Regional High School, assistance to area nonprofit organizations, a weekly community news show, and other community-service based projects. We are excited to award this scholarship to a Pembroke Resident who is receiving their high school diploma or equivalent from an accredited and licensed school or program. The Local Seen Scholarship committee will review all applications.

The Scholarship Committee will award a total of \$1,000 to the selected candidate. *This is a one-time award and will not recur in subsequent years to recipients. Preference will be given to students who have shown interest in a media related field.*

To be considered, this form must be completed and mailed or dropped off to The Local Seen Educational Access Department at 4 Collins Ave., Plymouth, by April 1, 2024.

Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Pembroke
- Must be graduating from high school or receiving a completion of studies from an equivalent type of educational program which is accredited and licensed to provide educational programming within the state of Massachusetts.
- Must be pursuing a communications-related field (i.e., film, video production, broadcast journalism, graphics arts, multi-media studies, digital media, visual arts, etc.) at an accredited 2- or 4-year college or a post high school technical school during the coming academic year.

Scholarship(s) will be awarded at Senior Awards Night Pembroke High School for students enrolled at PHS. Recipient(s), after successful completion of their first semester (with a C average or better) will mail a copy of their transcripts to Melissa Matinzi c/o The Local Seen, 4 Collins Ave., Plymouth, MA 02360. Once the transcript is received, a check will be mailed directly to the scholarship recipient(s).
