- Must be a current senior at Springfield Local High School and of attended Springfield Local High School for both your junior and senior years
- Your overall GPA must be 3.25 combined for all years in high school
- ACT score of 22

Required Documentation

- Completed / Signed Scholarship Fund Application (applicant and parent/guardian)
- Completed responses (last page of application)
- Latest Transcript from Springfield Local High School
- Copy of Acceptance letter from college of choice
- 3 letters of recommendation (at least two from Springfield Local Teaching faculty)

All Applications and required documentation must be returned to the Springfield Local High School guidance office by April 15, 2024.
