1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Gull Lake High School is a public school accepting any student who is a resident of our school district. We also accept school of choice students from within Kalamazoo County (105) and contiguous counties (105c).

2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

- Teachers will use Teach Like a Champion Engagement Strategies for all students to Read, Write, and Speak with Purpose, 6 Traits Writing, & Marzano's Six Steps to Building Academic Vocabulary as a framework for teaching vocabulary.
- Teachers will align the current curriculum to the state standards within district content maps and implement the curriculum with fidelity.
- Social Studies and Science teachers will assign inquiry activities in connection with labs and current event articles.
- All teachers will implement common rubrics, by department, designed to grade student work in a style consistent with SAT and state expectations.
- Staff will continue to use SAT and common assessment data to analyze student growth.

Gull Lake Schools also offers enrollment in Gateway Academy, which provides an alternative high school experience, and Virtual High School where online courses are offered.

7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT OUR SCHOOL AS REQUIRED PER STATE LAW:

- Gull Lake High School offers 19 GLHS & 34 Gull Lake Virtual Partnership Advanced Placement courses. Students can earn college credits based on AP Exam results.
- 282 AP courses were enrolled in the Fall of 2022. This number represents approximately 32% of all Gull Lake students eligible to take an AP course.
- Gull Lake High School had 299 students dual enroll at a local college or university over the past two school years. This number represents approximately 34% eligible to enroll.
- Over the past two school years, Gull Lake High School students have completed 464 dual enrollment courses making them eligible to receive college credit. 100% of all Gull Lake High School students who dual enroll earn or are eligible to receive college credit.
