The High School Fair

The LISEF Fair is an in-person event for 2023-24 (Round 1 and Round 2 are in-person). The Charles Duggan Long Island Science and Engineering Fair (LISEF) promotes and supports excellence in scientific inquiry in grades 9-12 by providing a competition for the most advanced high school projects. The participants in this fair have an opportunity to present to professionals in their subject areas from local universities, scientific institutions and professionals in the field. First place finalists from Round 2, on condition of final Scientific Review Committee (SRC) Approval, advance to the International Science and Engineering Fair. The Middle School Fair

The Society for Science and the Public (SSP) has partnered with Thermo Fisher to launch the Thermo Fisher Scientific Junior Innovation Challenge (JIC). This program is open to students in grades 6, 7 and 8, is in-person, and the participation cost is \$78 per project. Under the guidance of their teachers, students perform an investigation. The results of the investigation are presented at the regional LISEF - SSP Thermo Fisher Scientific Junior Innovation Challenge. The projects receiving a first place award are eligible to apply for the national Thermo Fisher JIC competition.
