Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at San Pasqual Union School

#### **Organizational Meeting**

- Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m
- Public was welcomed. The flag salute was recited.
- Superintendent Burroughs led Member Gourley and Member Murray in reciting the Oath of Office.
- Member Merz nominated Member Baker for the position of the Board President. Member Goe seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0
- Member Goe nominated Member Merz for the position of the Board Vice President. Member Gourley seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- Member Merz nominated Member Goe for the position of the Board Clerk. Member Baker seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- Member Goe made a motion to approve the recommended dates for the 2023 Board Meeting dates and times. Member Gourley seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- Meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.

#### Regular Session

- Report from closed session: No action was taken in closed session.
- Hearing of the Public: SPETA VP Jolene Mallory, Member at large Heather Johnson and Secretary Amanda Grano thanked the returning Board Members and welcomed new members. Handed out thank you cards.
- Member Merz motioned to approve the current agenda and minutes from the 11/08/2022 regular meeting. Member Goe seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.

- o Upcoming events: Sweetheart dance 2/25, BookFair 2/24-3/3 and Lunch on the Lawn 3/2
- o Kidchella, or Step it Up, new event in place of APEX
- Foundation:
  - o Granted three grants
    - o Kinder for "Kindergarten Museum of Greatness
    - o First grade for Literature and STEAM readers theater
    - o MS for math games
- Superintendent's Report:
  - o Welcome new members and returning board members
  - o COVID update:
    - o Starting to see slight uptick in cases
    - o 17 Cases this year
    - o Providing students and staff with at home tests, with intention of students and staff testing prior to returning
  - o Met with SDCOE's tech team
    - o Need to prepare to update systematic technology (Servers, switches, etc) and anticipate using Title IV and eRate funding to offset costs
    - o Tech infrastructure updates to include multifactor authentication- JPA not expected to cover loses if not in place
    - o We will pilot for the smalls
  - o Escondido Regional Safety Consortium
    - o Big topic of mental health in students discussed
    - o Huge uptake in suicide ideation
    - o Discussion on how best to respond
    - o Law enforcement is often not best to turn to when student is in crisis
  - o Events
    - o Hosted TK/K/1st grade Holiday Show cutest show you'll ever watch
    - o Tomorrow, three shows:
      - 8:45 AM 2/3 Littlest Christmas Tree school performance
      - 12 PM VAPA performs with high school students
      - 2 PM 2/3 Littlest Christmas Tree parent performance
    - o Thursday we will have 4 award assemblies with awards for academics, including new growth award for reading and math and character awards
    - o Minimum day 12/21 prior to winter break

- o Member Baker questioned if we can move our phone system to be cloud based? Superintendent Burroughs answered we expect our new system will be cloud based.
- o Member Gourley questioned who negotiates/sets prices on the system? Superintendent Burroughs answered that SDCOE and Mrs. Brown will work with him on reaching out to vendors.

#### Action/Discussion Items

- Rhonda Brown presented First Interim Report. Member Goe made a motion to approve the First Interim Report. Member Merz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0
- Member Merz made a motion to approve the annual and five year developer fee resolution. Member Murray seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0
- Superintendent Burroughs shared the need to increase substitute teacher pay to attract and retain substitute teachers, especially quality long-term substitute teachers. Also shared the need to start long-term sub rates on Day 11. Member Gourley made a motion to approve the authorization to increase daily and long term sub teacher rates. Member Goe seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
- Superintendent Burroughs shared concerns regarding the solar consulting proposal.

  Member Merz made a motion to approve the solar energy consulting agreement. Member Goe seconded the motion. After Board discussion, motion did not pass 0/5 with request for additional information to be provided at a future meeting
- Superintendent Burroughs shared calendars created with input from School Site Council and SPETA. Member Murray made a motion to approve the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school year District calendars. Member Goe seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.

Member Goe motioned to approve the consent agenda. Member Merz seconded the motion. Member Motion passed 5/0.
