Foursquare Rules



Remember to SOAR:

Stay **S**afe and Show **S**elf Control, **O**n Task, **A**ccepting of others, and **R**espectful and **R**esponsible.

- You need at least 4 players to play.
- The server stands in the number 4 square or the Ace position and the receiver stands in the number 1 or the Jack position.
- Use an underhand serve.
- The object of the game is to hit the ball off of one bounce or no bounce into someone else's square.
- If you make a mistake you're out.
- New players always move into position 1. All other players get to advance in the order of Jack, Queen, King, Ace.
- Players who are waiting their turn or who are out stand in a line by position 1.
- The first player in line is the **judge/referee**. You may never argue with the referee's call.





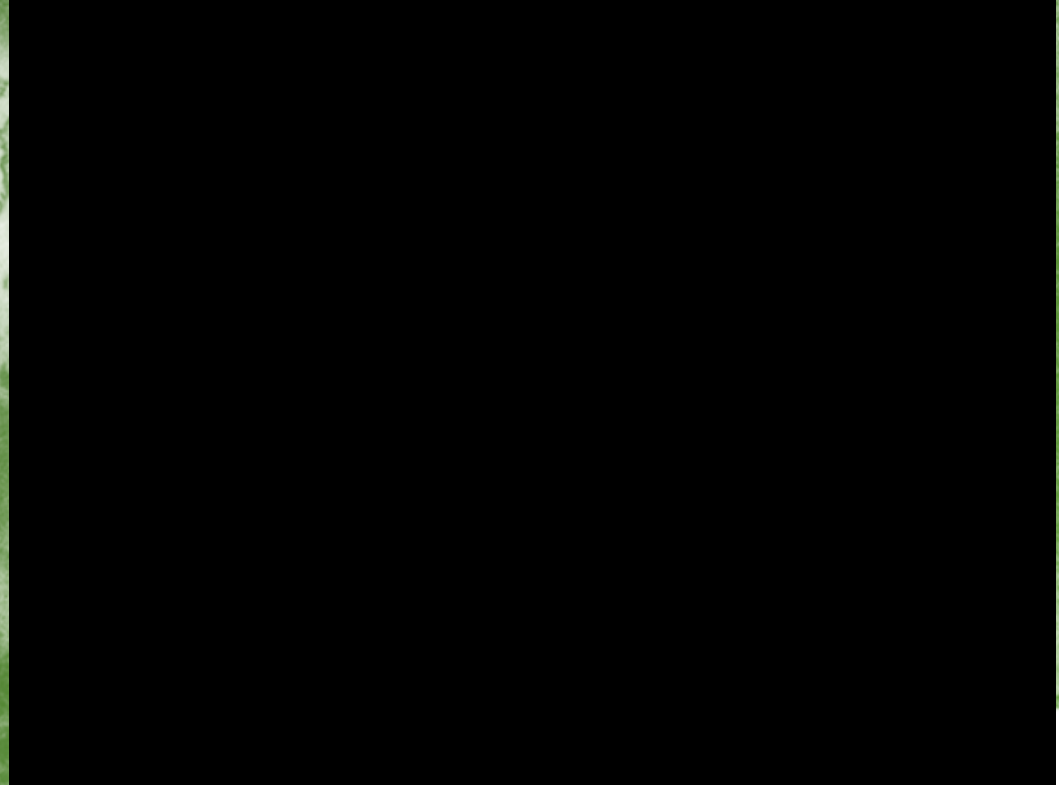
Gaga Ball Rules



Remember to SOAR:

Stay **S**afe and Show **S**elf Control, **O**n Task, **A**cepting of others, and **R**espectful and **R**esponsible.

- First out doesn't count
- All players start with one hand touching the pit wall.
- The game begins with a referee throwing the ball into the center of the pit.
- Once the ball is in play, any player can hit the ball with an open or closed hand.
- If the ball touches a player below the knee (even if the player hits him/herself) he or she is out and leaves the pit. If the player is hit above the knees, the play continues.
- If you are out, you must stand outside the wall. If you catch the ball on the fly, you can re-enter.
- If the ball is caught on the fly by a player who is out, the player gets to re-enter the game and the last player who hit the ball is out.
- If the ball goes outside the Gaga ball pit, the last player to touch the ball is out.
- Using the walls of the octagon to aid in jumping is legal as long as the player does not permanently sit on the ledge of the wall.
- Players cannot hold the ball.
- No double hits.
- The last player standing is the winner of the game.





Play Structure Rules



Remember to SOAR:
Stay **S**afe, **O**n Task, **A**ccepting of others, and **R**espectful



1. Only go down the slide, seated.
2. Use safe feet (no jumping off).
3. Wood chips stay on the ground.
4. Remain seated on the swings and count 30 bananas; then take turns.



5. Tag is only on the grass area.



6. Have fun and play together!






Blue Spinner Rules



Remember to SOAR:
Stay **S**afe, **O**n Task, **A**ccepting of others, and **R**espectful



1. Maximum of 7 students at a time
 - a. (3 seated, 3 standing, 1 pushing).
2. Sit on "Sitting Part" and stand on "Standing Part"
3. STOP  if someone falls off. 
4. Form a line  on the grass and wait your turn.
5. Count to 30 and then everyone exits the spinner for those in line.
6. Remain on the spinner while it's moving (no jumping).
