Regular Session

- Meeting reconvened at 6:14 p.m.
- Public was welcomed. The flag salute was recited.
- Report from Closed Session: The Board gave the Superintendent direction on closed session agenda items.
- Hearing of the Public: No one addressed the Board.
- Member Zdunich motioned to approve the current agenda and minutes from the 4/5/2022 regular meeting. Member Czerwonka seconded the motion. Motion passed 5/0.
