This paper application is for use <u>only</u> for the following students:

- Current non-CPS students attending private, charter or home schools who live within CPS' district boundaries and who want to enter CPS' high schools in the UPPER GRADES (10, 11, 12)
- Current CPS high school students who want to change high schools

Who does <u>not</u> use this paper application:

- Students now attending <u>a CPS elementary school in grades 6, 7 and 8,</u> or their parents/guardians, must apply to CPS' high schools through the district's **online lottery application system** from any Internet-connected computer.
- Non-CPS students who <u>live</u> within CPS' district boundaries and attend a non-CPS elementary school (private, charter or home schools) apply to CPS' high schools through the **online lottery application system** from home or by using a computer at the **CPS' Customer Care Center** office (2651 Burnet Avenue, Corryville, 45219).

- Students are expected to remain in their selected high school programs for the entire 2024-2025 school year.
