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Dear Tenafly High School Parents and Guardians,

As you are probably aware, we are required by federal regulations to assess our students in English Language Arts/Literacy, Mathematics, and Science. Testing dates for our high school students are listed below.

MARCH 12th – 15th: NJGPA Grade 11 ONLY

3/12 - 3/13 @8:10am: 2 Days/Units ELA
3/14 - 3/15 @8:10am: 2 Days/Units Math

MAY 20th - 23rd: NJSLA Grade 9 ONLY

5/20 - 5/21 @8:10am: 2 Days/Units ELA
5/22 - 5/23 @8:10am: 2 Days/Units Math

MAY 20th & 21st: NJSLA Grade 11 ONLY

5/20 - 5/21 @8:10am: 2 Days/4 Units Science

On testing days, THS will follow the condensed bell schedule that will be shared by the principal shortly. Testing students should arrive at school at 8:00am and report directly to testing rooms. Non-testing students can arrive by 10:30 for their first class. If students arrive earlier, they must remain in the cafeteria until the building is released for classes.

It is imperative that students arrive at school on time by 8 a.m. for all test administration days. Arriving late to school may result in your child having to make up a section of the assessment during class time the following week.

Our Tenafly teachers prepare students for NJGPA and NJSLA assessments. Our curriculum is aligned with NJ Student Learning Standards and our students are regularly presented with the skills and knowledge essential for performing well on these tests. We believe that a strong curriculum, rather than isolated test prep, is the best way to prepare students for all types of assessments.
