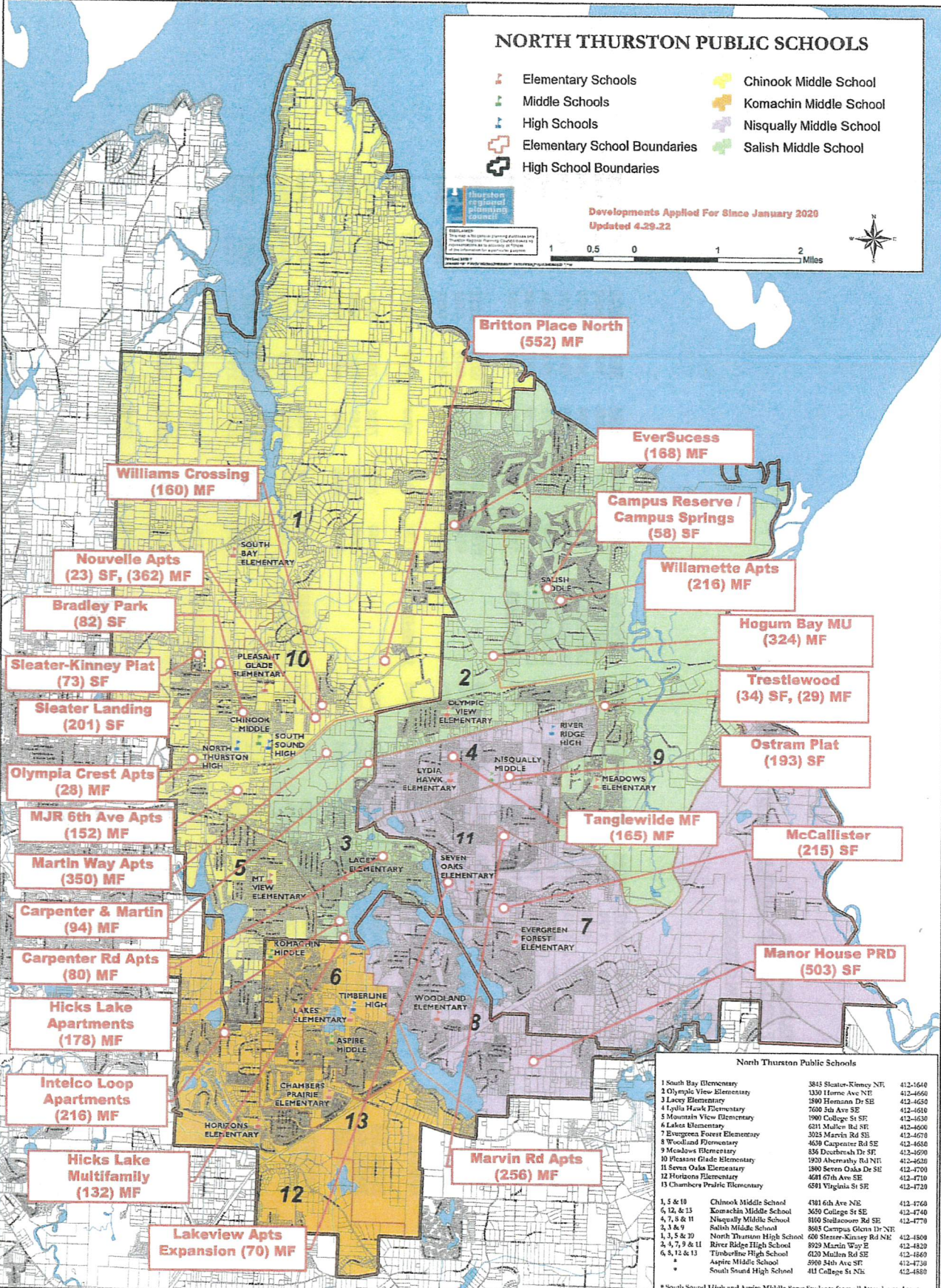

**Agenda:**

Troy reviewed the agenda for the evening and talked about the committee's role in reviewing boundaries. He also reviewed the School Board's guidance while doing this work which include:

Troy then talked with the group about NTPS' current reality in regards to school enrollment, future planned growth in the community, existing NTPS school boundaries, and the current school feeder patterns.

**Action:**

The group was split into 6 groups of 5-7 members. Each group was given a large laminated map to begin to propose changes by outlining areas and the intended moves. At the end of the meeting the maps and proposed changes were collected. The district will collect data on the impacts of the proposed changes and share that with the group at the next meeting. This will help the group determine if those moves meet the School Board's guidance on new boundaries.
