**Make-up testing** will occur throughout the month and continue up until May 31st, if necessary.

### Electronics Policy

**Unauthorized electronics (cell phones, e-readers, Smartwatches, etc...) are NOT permitted at any time during testing.**

Prior to the test, each teacher will remind students to verify that they have turned off all electronics and that they are in their lockers/backpacks away from the testing location.

**Should an unauthorized electronic device be observed during testing, it would be considered a security breach requiring the school to notify the NJDOE immediately of the violation.**

- o The student's test will be stopped and possibly voided pending an investigation as to the extent of the security breach.
- o The device will be confiscated to be returned to the child's parent upon completion of the investigation and guidance from the NJDOE.
