

# FRANKFORT-SCHUYLER CSD - STUDENT AND EDUCATOR REPORT [2020 - 21]

The Student and Educator Report provides information to the public about students eligible for free or reduced-price lunch; student attendance and suspensions; and school/district average class size, staff counts, and teacher attendance and turnover.

### FREE AND REDUCED-PRICE LUNCH (2020-21)
