Academic Opportunities

To ensure that all of our students are college- and career-ready, Conway High offers a wide array of course options on the college preparatory, world language, honors, and advanced placement levels while providing students with a comprehensive high school experience that includes opportunities in the fine arts and athletics, as well as in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). Students enrolled in our school have the opportunity to participate in various Advanced Placement courses. These courses include AP English Literature and Composition, AP English Language and Composition, AP Human Geography, AP Environmental Science, AP Art, AP Calculus AB and BC, AP Statistics, AP Government, AP European History, and AP US History. Conway High is also proud to offer students a rigorous, nationally recognized STEM program where students can use 21st-century skills to solve hands-on, real-world problems. Students enrolled in our Project Lead the Way Engineering, Computer Science, and Biomedical Science programs earn honors credit and can potentially earn dual-enrollment credit. Students who enroll in Pharmacology Technology, Veterinary Science, and Hospitality and Tourism can potentially earn a national certification that can launch them into a career immediately after graduating from high school. Other STEM offerings offered at Conway High include Health Science. Sports Medicine, and Horticulture/Agricultural Science.


Entrance Requirements
