The Academy for the Arts, Science and Technology (AAST) is a program academy located in Horry County, South Carolina and is part of the Horry County School system. Based on interest in one of the career- focused major programs at the academy, students apply to attend AAST during their junior and senior years of high school, In addition to career focused major courses, AAST offers students a variety of rigorous academic options designed to prepare them for their post-secondary goals and to complement their major course of study.

AAST has a longstanding reputation in Horry County as being a school of innovation and excellence. Students at AAST have led Horry County Schools in accomplishments related to the school's career cluster majors: Engineering, Health Sciences, Information Technologies, and Fine Arts. The faculty and staff at AAST work extremely hard to make the educational experience worth the student sacrifice of leaving the base school environment. Students apply rigorous academic content while exploring career fields in their major.

In April of 2021, AAST renewed its accreditation from Cognia (formerly AdvancEd) as a whole school STEM learning environment through a rigorous, research-based, evaluative process. The school has adopted the Koi fish as its unofficial mascot. Like the Koi, which will grow as large as its environment will allow, the students at AAST are encouraged to take advantage of the many great learning opportunities the school has to offer as a means of fostering their individual growth.

## Course Offerings

AAST major programs offer many STEM elective classes in the areas of Engineering, Health Sciences, Information Technologies, and Fine Arts. AAST offers honors in all four content areas as well as in foreign language starting at the third level. AAST offers 20 Advanced Placement courses. Dual Enrollment course opportunities through Horry Georgetown Technical College include: English 101, English 102, Psychology 201, Sociology 101, Sociology, Speech 102, Math 120, Music Appreciation 105, and Speech 205. Students who have room in their schedules for additional fine arts credits can take Art or Theatre electives at the school as well.
