When students follow the school expectations, the instructional educational plan can be implemented at its best. Teachers are able to teach in a conducive environment and students are able to learn in an environment that is comfortable, safe, and encourages learning.

ROAR points

Students will receive ROAR points from staff who observe them following the behavioral expectations. Students can use these points in the ROAR store twice a week.

Raffles

Students can save up their ROAR points to enter them into a school wide raffle for a big ticket item once every quarter.

School Wide Celebrations

Every quarter we will celebrate students that had not received a referral for 45 days. These students will enjoy extra recess with a treat, as well as receive ROAR points.

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WAYS TO HELP YOUR STUDENT STAY ON THE PATH TO POSITIVE BEHAVIOR

Home and school have a shared responsibility to help our students grow in to productive citizens. Parents/Guardians, teachers, and students must work together to maintain a positive leaning environment for all students.
