## Requirements:

- 1. Meet one day per week first semester either face to face or virtual.
- 2. Meet two days per week beginning March 1st.
- 3. Excessive absences will result in dismissal from the team. It is important to be present. Your team members are depending on you. (Sports and school activities may be excused with written notice **before** the meeting. Absences due to sickness are also excused.)
- 4. Complete your book by each deadline, typically every two weeks.
- 5. There will be several Title and Author Quizzes written and oral each semester. Mastery is expected by the end of first semester.
- 6. Participate in book discussions, quizzes, mock battles, etc.
- 7. Maintain a C average in all classes.

We will have incentive prizes, snacks, and special celebrations throughout the school year just for our team!
