Instructional <u>STRETCH</u> Goal

By focusing on the quality rather than the quantity of assignments, all teachers will provide students with more actionable feedback which will lead to 100% of TOMS students meeting their projected growth targets on the Spring Math and Reading MAP tests.

School Improvement Goals

- → 60% of all students at Ten Oaks Middle School in grades 6-8 will meet their Fall to Spring Target Growth Goal as measured by the Spring 2022 Math MAP assessment.
- → Through the utilization common assessments, by June 2022, Ten Oaks Middle School will improve the percentage of students scoring Met or Exemplary on SC Ready and SC PASS by no less than 5%.

Read to Succeed Goals

- → Through the implementation of disciplinary literacy strategies, at least 90% of students in grades 6-8 will score "Approaching" (Level 2) or above on the ELA SCReady assessment by 2022.
- → Through using Common Assessments, Ten Oaks Middle School will improve the percentage of students scoring Met (Level 3) or Exemplary (Level 4) on SC Ready and SC PASS by no less than 5% by June 2022.
- → Through the strategic use of sheltered instruction strategies, at least 90% of students in grades 6-8 will score "Approaching" (Level 2) or above on the ELA SCReady assessment by 2022.

Social Emotional Learning Goals

- → During the 2021-2022 school year, all students and teachers will complete SEL lessons based on the theme of safety. The lessons and their effectiveness will be determined based on student surveys delivered through a variety of formats. By the end of the year, surveys will show a 10% increase in students who feel safe when compared to baseline data.
- → During the 2021-2022 school year, all students and teachers will complete SEL lessons based on the theme of accountability. The lessons and their effectiveness will be determined by a 10% reduction in overall student discipline referrals based on data from the 2021-2022 school year.
- → During the 2021-2022 school year, all students and teachers will complete SEL lessons based on the theme of communication. The lessons and their effectiveness will be determined by an increase of positive responses on a student self-assessment to be completed at the beginning of the school year and the end of each quarter.
