

Athletic Liaison Report 2/15/24

HS Girls Basketball: Girls basketball finished the regular season with a 20-2 record. They placed second in their section to Columbia, who is responsible for our only two losses. Due to placing second in the section they qualified for league playoffs where we faced Ephrata last Saturday in the opening round. Ephrata came out on top in a very competitive and well played 43-40 win over Pequea. The girls now have their focus set on the first round of districts. Pequea Valley, the three seed will host, Upper Dauphin, the six seed in the opening round of districts. The game will be held in our high school gym at 7 pm on Monday night. With a district win the girls will clinch a state play-off berth which they hope to do for the third year in a row.
