

Administrative Personnel

Section A - Positions

The Board of Education directs the superintendent to prescribe positions for all administrators subject to compliance with relevant legal requirements and the provisions of the contract between each administrator and the Board.

Section B - Working Conditions

The Board of Education directs the superintendent to develop policies and procedures for administrators, including but not limited to, health examinations, workload, travel expenses, non-school employment, professional leaves, emergency leaves, absences, and vacations, subject to compliance with relevant legal requirements and the provisions of the contract between each administrator and the Board.

Section C - Fringe Benefits

The Board of Education directs the superintendent to recommend to the Board fringe benefit compensation provisions for administrators.

Section D - Professional Development Opportunities

The Board of Education recognizes that administrators should stay abreast of theories and methods consistent with their position and responsibilities. Administrators shall be expected to attend professional meetings and periodic workshops to improve skills consistent with their position and approved by the superintendent or his/her designee.

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
