


This is ALICE.




At school, ALICE is here to help us prepare.



ALICE is alert. She pays attention. She listens to adults.




If she sees something scary, ALICE may have to listen to her teacher and lockdown the classroom. She listens to adults.




If ALICE sees something scary, she should inform and tell adults.

She listens to adults.




ALICE protects and stands up for herself by countering. This means your teacher may tell you it is okay to throw water bottles, binders, and other objects. She listens to adults.
