



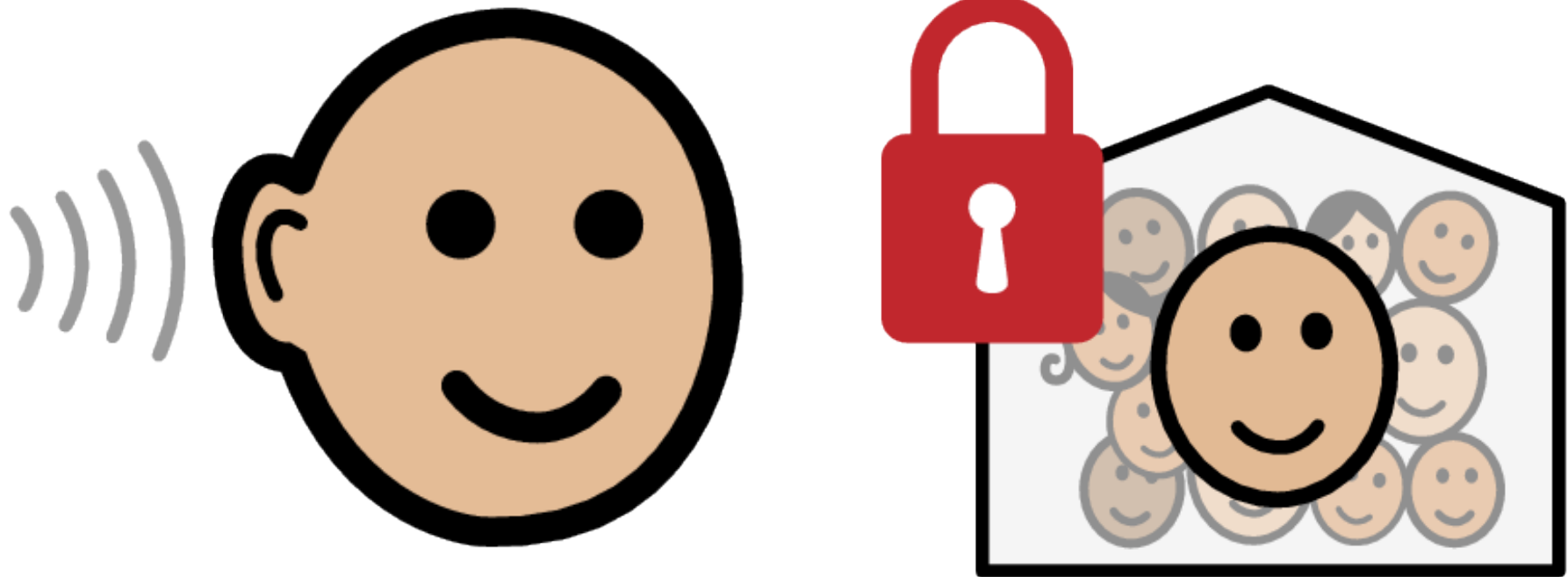
This is ALICE.



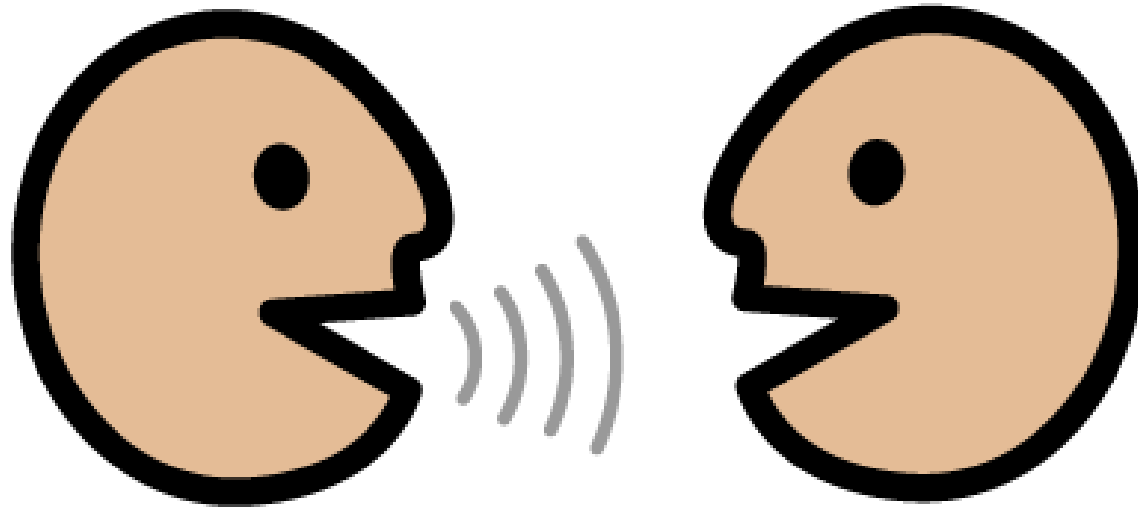
At school, ALICE is here to help us prepare.



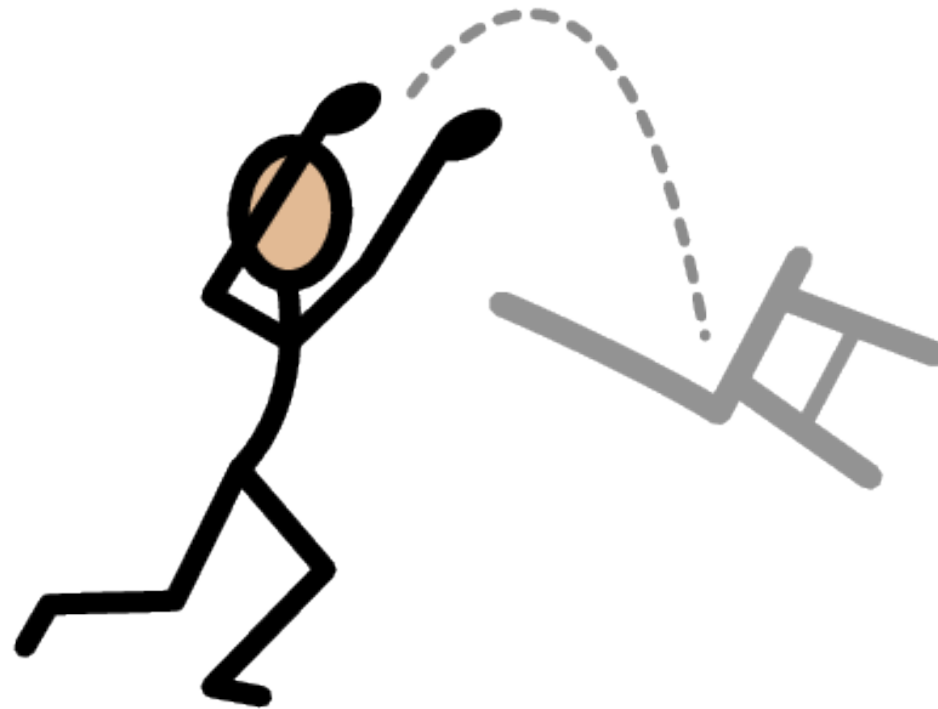
ALICE is **alert**. She pays attention. She listens to adults.



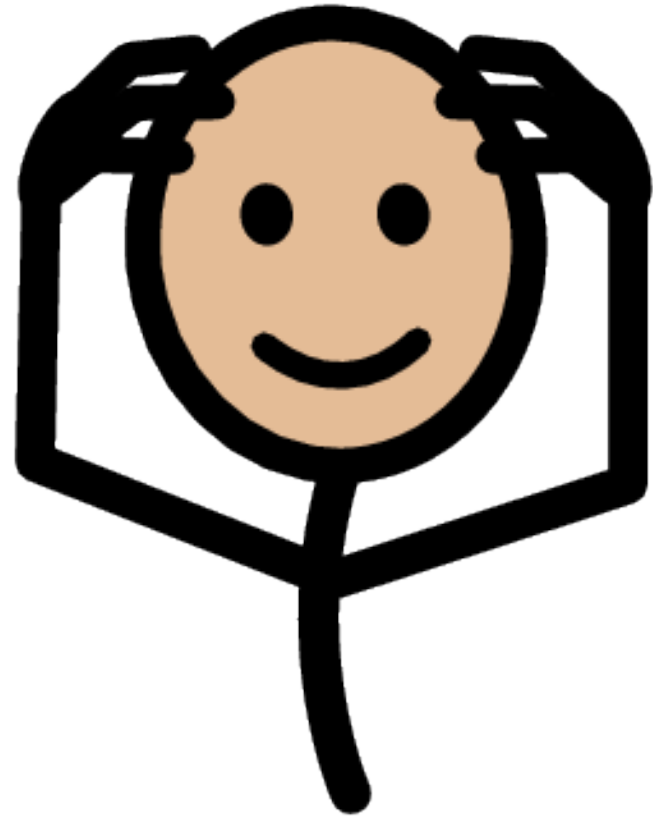
If she sees something scary, ALICE may have to listen to her teacher and **lockdown** the classroom. She listens to adults.



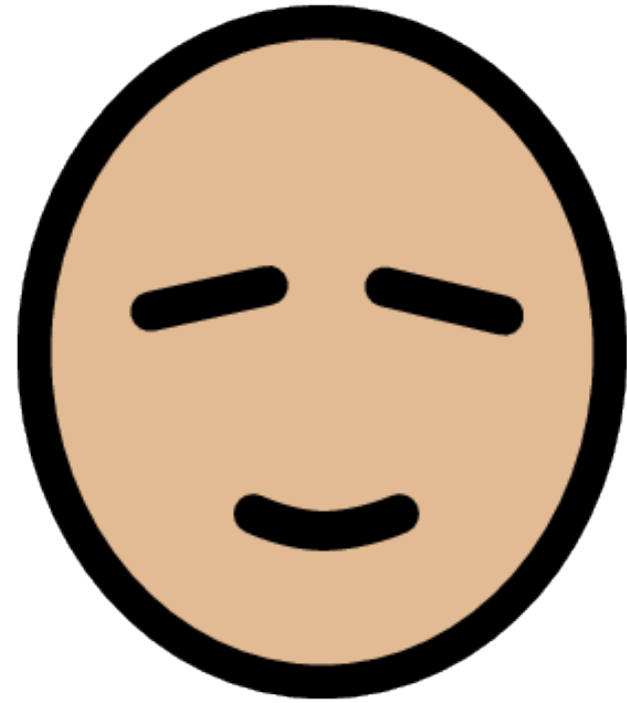
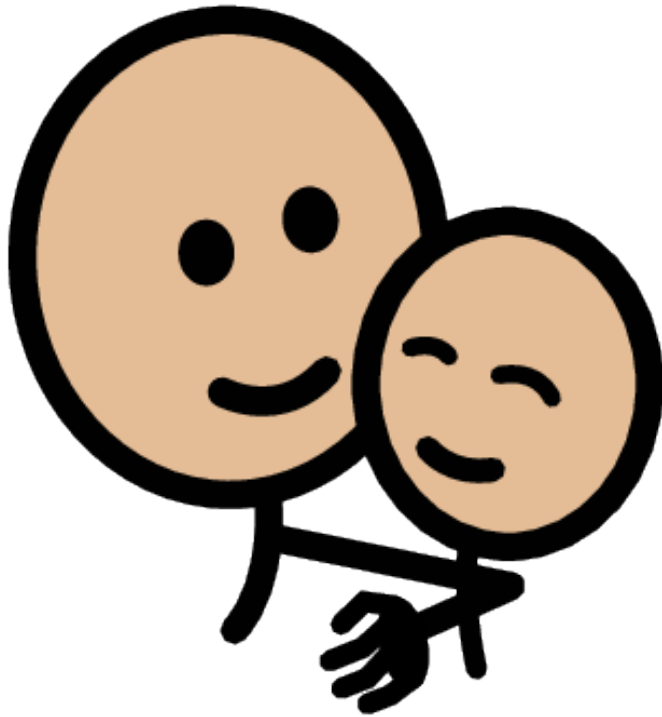
If ALICE sees something scary, she should **inform** and tell adults.
