




ELA and math performance data has improved from beginning to mid-year

Less than 5% of all first semester grades were D/Fs








Fall to Winter Growth: 6% Increase in **Tiers 1-2**


### **LBHS Course Grades**

LBHS First Semester Grade Distribution 2023-24




### **TMS Course Grades**


