#### SPU COVID-19 Updates

> 21 Cases this school year  $(\frac{1}{2} \text{ in November})$ 13 non-school impacts 8 minimal school impacts On-Site COVID Testing (Antigen & PCR) Symptomatic Exposure ("modified quarantine") Post Holiday & At-Home Testing Kits

#### Mask Mandate Update

- Current
  - Masks mandated indoors when students are present
- Effective Wednesday, 12/15/21
  - Masks mandated in all indoor spaces (Statewide Indoor Mask Mandate)
  - ▷ To be re-evaluated 1/15/22

#### Vaccine Mandate Overview

- Governor's vaccination requirement not yet in effect.
- All vaccine mandates issued by the Governor includes broad "personal belief" exemptions
- Legality of vaccine mandates currently in place (i.e., San Diego Unified School District) are being challenged in court.

#### Governor's Potential Mandate

10/1/21, Governor announced he has directed CDPH to add the COVID-19 vaccine to list of required vaccinations to attend in-person instruction To commence the semester after which the FDA grants full approval for the gradespan (K-6th & 7th-12th)

#### **Vaccine Status**

- Currently FDA has granted Pfizer vaccine:
  - Full approval for ages 16+
  - Emergency approval for ages 5-15
- Full approval for grades 7-12th expected before 7/1/22
- Full approval for grades K-6 TBD

#### **Personal Belief Exemption**

- Current 10 required vaccinations for school do not include a Personal Belief Exemption
  To add COVID-19 vaccination to this list, the Legislature and Governor would need to pass a law to add it.
- Would require a <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> supermajority in both houses
- Earliest effective date: January 2023

#### So, what does that mean for kids @ SPU?

Short answer . . . nothing yet If 7th-12th grade mandate goes into effect 7/1/22, broad personal belief exemption in effect Earliest projected date mandate could take effect in law (i.e. without personal belief exemption) 1/1/2023

#### What is the role of the school board?

Advocate for students Academic, Social, Emotional, Safety, etc. Maintain fiscal and legal integrity Keep the Superintendent in line! The school board does not determine mask mandates, vaccine requirements, or other health directives.
